



## ACROSS

- 2 seed head like a hot-dog-on-a-stick
- 6 vitamin-rich tea made from needle-leaves of this tree
- 7 bruised twigs almond-scented
- 8 source of *Aronia* berry juice
- 9 spicy tree with some mitten-shaped leaves
- 11 taproot of this biennial has radish-like bite
- 14 bitter tasting lawn plant with yellow flowers
- 15 important mast tree of Northeast forests
- 16 *Rubus* sp. with bloom-covered purple stem

## DOWN

- 1 developing nuts on this tree resemble tennis balls
- 3 leaves and red fruit covered in silver dots
- 4 young shoots edible, but quickly grow over 5' tall
- 5 shoots with coarsely toothed leaves and garlicky taste
- 9 most commonly tapped tree
- 10 similar to Concord varieties, but not seedless
- 12 dried flowers of this legume make a fine tea
- 13 red fruit clusters used to make a lemonade-like drink
